Client Profile:

Ability Options provide services focusing on independence, empowerment and meaningful lifestyles for people with a disability.

Scope of Works:

Refurbishment of an existing area while in occupation. The fitout included specialist areas for arts and crafts, sensory rooms and a kitchen training facility.

Specialist works Included:

- Design and build the fitout to AS1428.1 2009 design for access and mobility
- ▲ Installation of high visibility anti slip stair nosing
- Wide door ways, passing spaces and exclusion of dead end spaces
- Specialist sensory room lighting system
- ▲ Vinyl floors with turned up wall finish
- ▲ Design and installation of an accessible kitchen training area including: side opening oven doors, draw dishwashers, multi height stainless steel benches and compliant sinks and tapware.

Challenges:

Take responsibility for the health, safety and wellbeing of the participants that Ability Options supports during the construction process. The fitout needed to comply to AS1428.1 2009.

Solution:
