Updated legislation to the Building Code of Australia (BCA) 2019 came into force on 1st May and includes important amendments to access regulations for people with disability.

Some key areas that have been improved include:

- New verification methods for access ramps and paths of travel
- Location of exit door push buttons
- Braille and tactile signs
- Adult change facilities.

We take building regulations very seriously and one of our key objectives is to ensure all building work carried out meets current building codes and regulations and improves the workplace for all without discrimination of any kind.

Compliance with the new regulations is important for improving access for people with disability in the workplace. Failure to comply whether intentionally or not could cause delays in the granting of an occupation certificate.
